- **Welcome Function INTROZIA 2020 –**

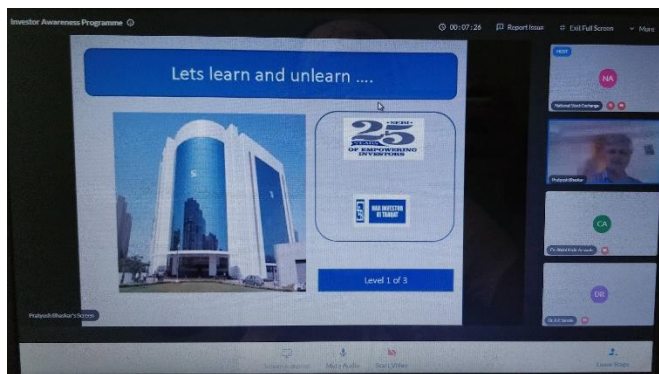

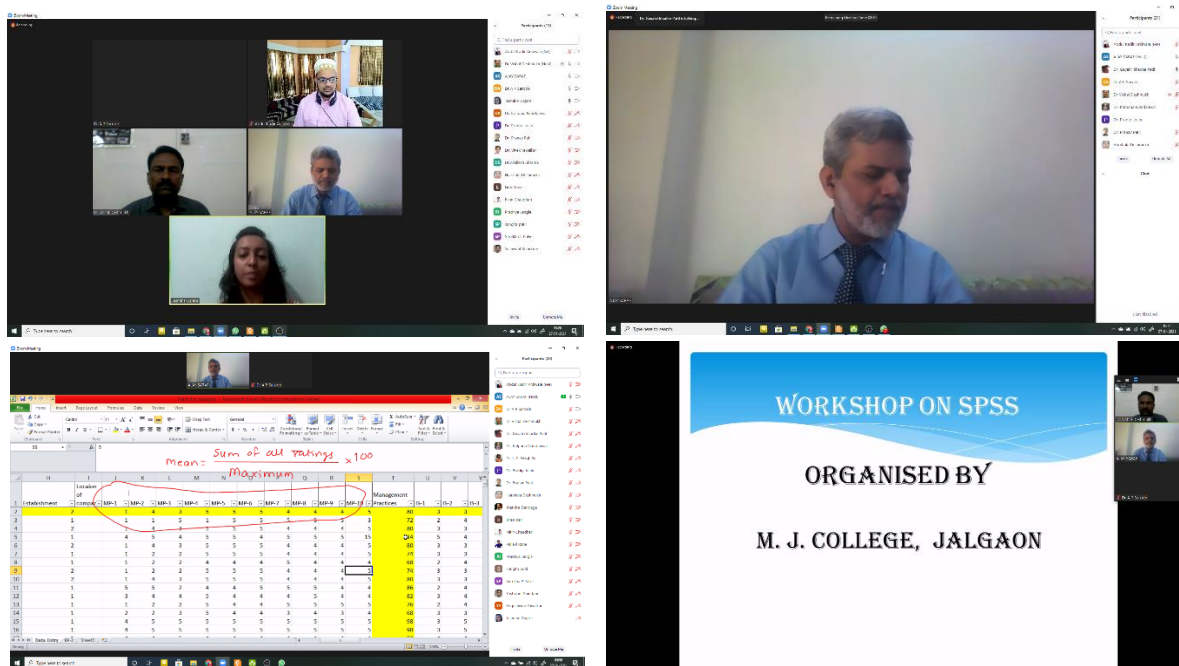


- **Workshop on SPSS:**

- Faculty doubts regarding the SPSS software were discussed and solved.

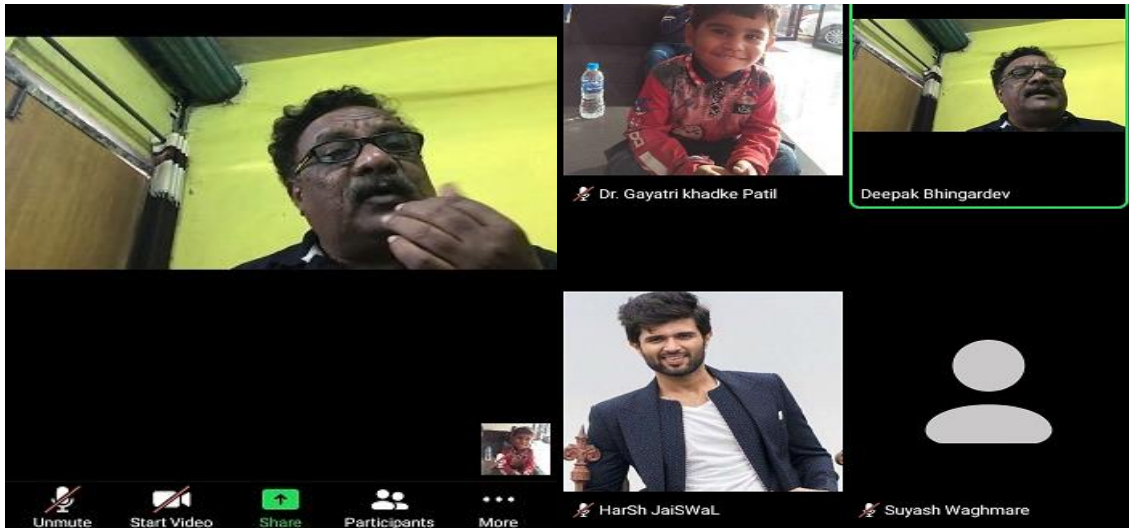
A total of 30 faculty members from Faculty of Arts, Commerce & Science participated in the workshop.

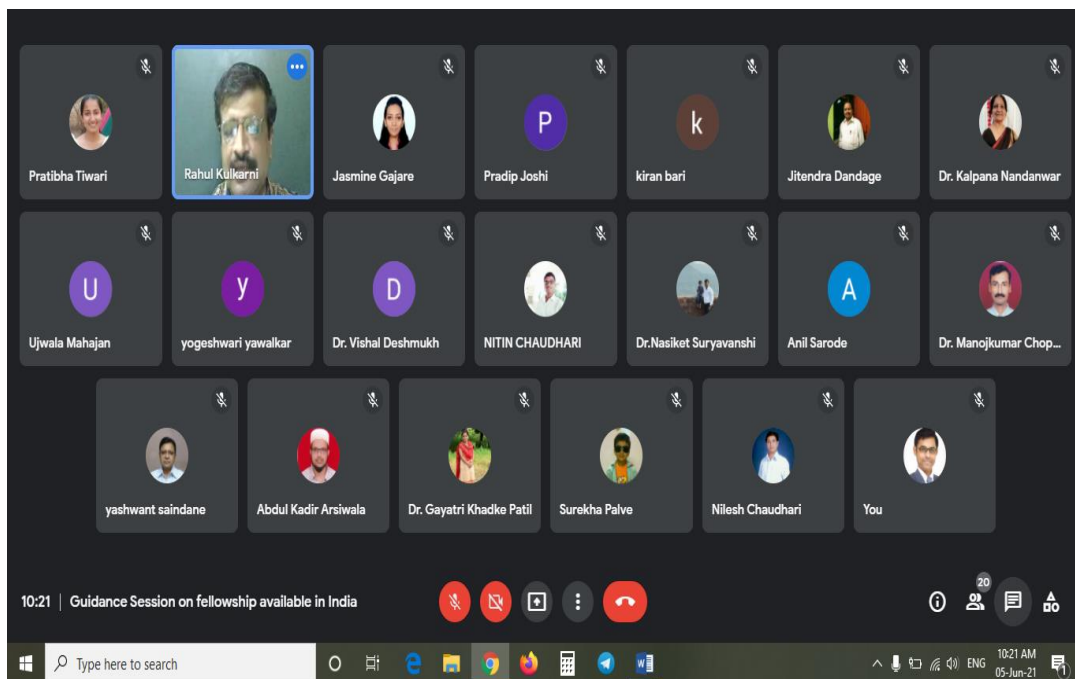

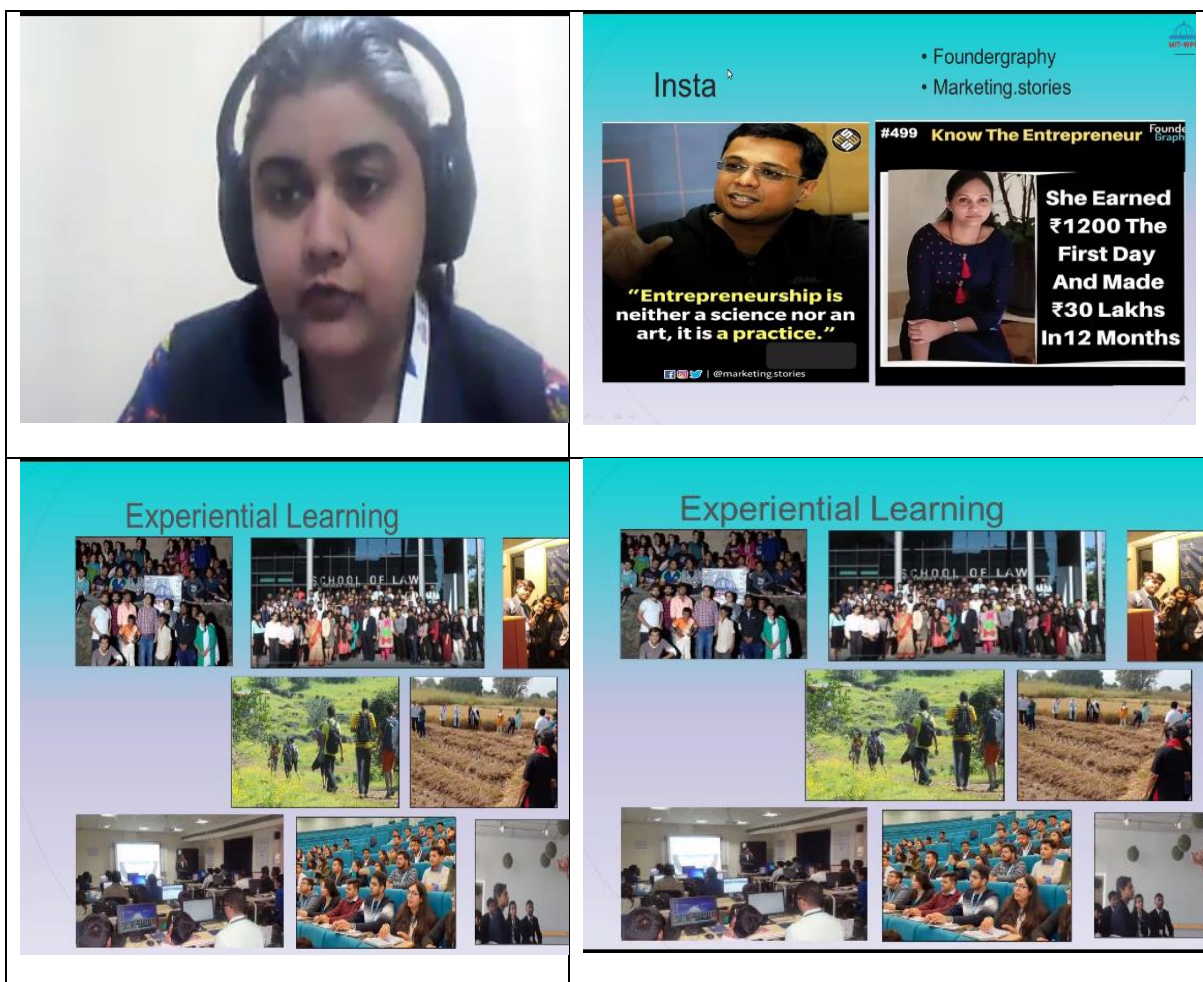


- **Webinar on Entrepreneurship as a Career Choice.**

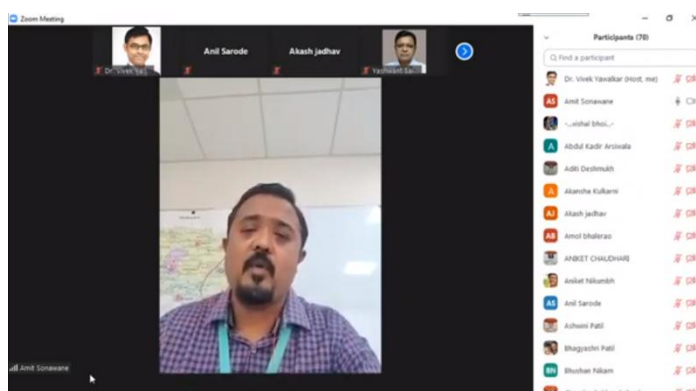


QUALITY CIRCLE EVENTS
