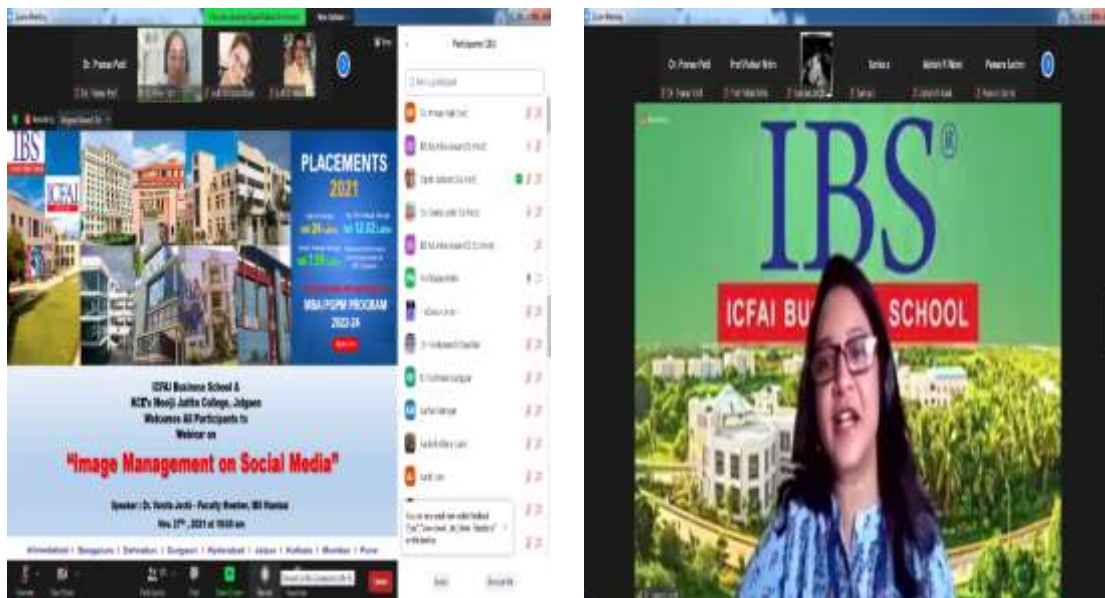

- **Student Development Program**

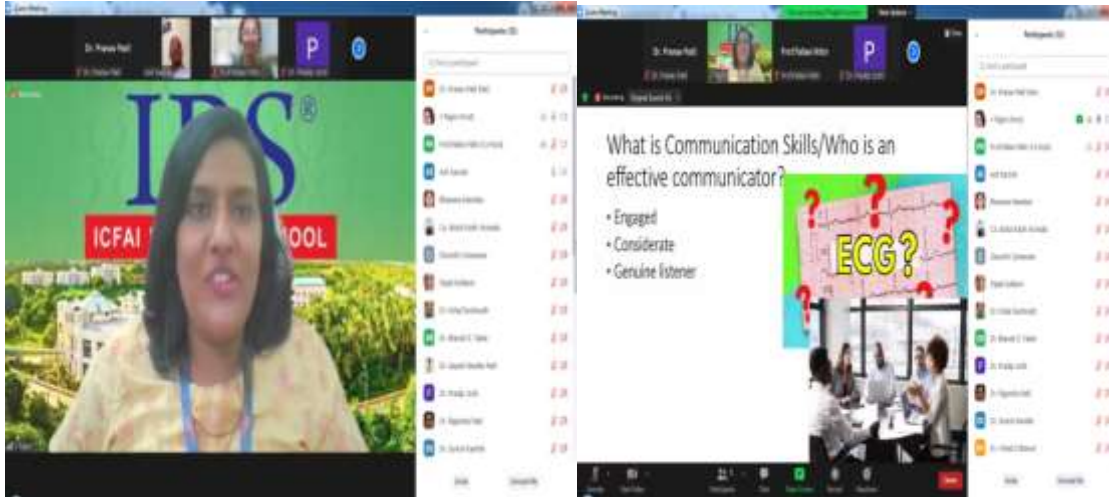

- **Workshop on MCQ Paper Setting:**

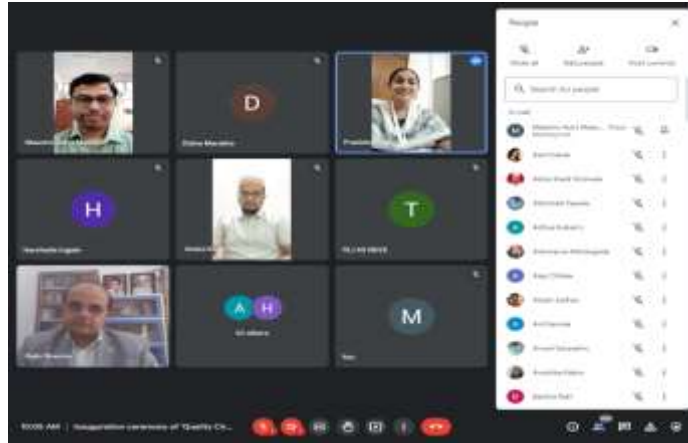
