Faculty of Science, KCES's, Moolji Jaitha College (Autonomous), Jalgaon has organized a lecture/workshop on “Cyber Security Awareness Programme” for the FYBSc students on **29th August 2024**, Thursday at 3.00 pm in the **M-31 classroom** (FYBSc Classroom at main building). **Ms. Aakansha Mahajan, and Ms. Chaaya Mistari (M.Sc. Computer, KBC-NMU, Jalgaon)** were available as resource persons for the workshop.

The workshop was opened with the introduction of resource persons given by the **Dr. Rajendra D Patil, Assistant Professor**. This is followed by the brief introduction about cyber security and the importance of awareness of cyber security in the current scenario.

Department of Computer Science






