Allocation of seats

The percentage of allocation of seats for various types of candidates in the Home University (HU), Other than Home University (OHU), Institutional (Management) Quota, and Industry Sponsored Seats is as follows:

1. Allocation Seats for Granted Courses

- Candidates graduated from KBCNMU, Jalgaon : 90%
- Candidates graduated from other universities : 10%

2. Allocation Seats for Non Granted Courses

- Candidates graduated from KBCNMU, Jalgaon : 70%
- Candidates graduated from other universities : 10%
- Seats to be allotted through management quota : 20%

3. Allocation of seats will be on 'first come first basis' as per the merit and eligibility of student for opted course.

4. In case of any dispute or discrepancy regarding grant of seat and eligibility, the decision taken by the Hon'ble Principal shall be final.

Reservations:

All the reservations given below shall be applicable to candidates belonging to Maharashtra state only subject to the fulfilment of the eligibility criteria specified by respective authorities from time to time.

- (a) **Reservation for backward class category candidates:** The percentage of seats reserved for candidates of backward class categories belonging to Maharashtra state is as given below. The percentage of reservation is the percentages of the seats available for Maharashtra candidates. Backward class candidates shall claim the category to which they belong to at the time of submission of application form.

(b) **Reservation for wards of defence service personnel:** Five percent (5%) seats out of total sanctioned intake capacity of college as a whole separately, subject to a maximum of one (01) seat in each subject coming under CAP shall be reserved for wards of ex- service personnel who are from Maharashtra state.

(c) **Reservation for persons with disability candidates:** Five percent (5%) seats of total sanctioned intake capacity of a college as a whole separately, subject to a maximum of one (01) seat in each subject coming under CAP shall be reserved for candidates with disability. The allotment of seats reserved for the candidates with disability shall be done on the basis of merit. The candidates claiming reservation under this category shall submit the Physical Disability certificates.

Note: - Candidates with disability should note that on admission to degree course they will not be given any exemptions or additional facility in the academic activities other than those which may be provided by the college.

Government of India (GOI) has prescribed the following list of twenty-one types disabilities for Specially/Differently Abled Persons’:

(d) If the reservation quota remains vacant then 2% seats of total intake capacity of a college as a whole separately will be offered to SBC category.

(e) **Reservation for EWS (Economical Weaker Section) Candidate:** As per the provisions in Government Resolution No. राआधो-4019/ प्र.क्र..31/16- अ, dated 12th February 2019, 10% seats shall be reserved for EWS candidates. These seats shall be filled by the Competent Authority through CAP as per the policies of the Government declared from time to time.

(f) **Reservation for SEBC:** According to ‘The Maharashtra state reservation for socially and educationally backward classes act, 2024, (Section 5), dated 29th February, 2024, 10% seats shall be reserved for SEBC candidates in educational institutions including private educational institutions, whether aided or un-aided by the State, other than minority educational institutions referred to in clause (1) of article 30 of the Constitution of India.

The principle of Creamy Layer shall be applicable for the purposes of reservation to the Socially and Educationally Backward Classes under this Act and reservation under this Act shall be available only to the persons belonging to the Socially and Educationally Backward Classes who are not falling in Creamy Layer.

(g) If sufficient candidates from Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University area are not available for admission for various post graduate courses, candidates from other universities will be considered. Similarly, if candidates from other universities are not available for admission, the candidates from Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University will be considered for admission. There will be separate merit list for other university students.

(h) Any change from Government side in terms of reservation before the commencement of allotment of seats will be taken under consideration.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1) Purchase the Prospectus from Consumer store in the college and read the instructions carefully before filling up the Application Form.
- 2) Candidate must provide at least one valid mobile number and e-mail ID for creation of user ID as a direct contact made with college office.
- 3) Candidates should adhere to the rules and regulations of the college for the smooth conduct of admissions (2024-2025).
- 4) Applications with incorrect/wrong information will not be considered in the process of admission.

- 8) In case of any dispute or discrepancy regarding grant of seat and eligibility, the decision taken by the Hon'ble Principal shall be final.

HOW TO APPLY?

- 1) After purchasing prospectus from 'Consumer Store' in the college campus, visit the department in which you wish to enrol for M.A. course.
- 2) Admission Counsellor in the department will guide you to register and fill your online application. After successful registration, your admission form will be filled by counsellor in the department only.

- 3) Documents must be properly scanned and uploaded.
- 4) Save the application form by clicking the "Save" button.
- 5) Check all information entered once again and edit, if required, before submission.
- 6) Preview all the information entered once again and edit, if required, before submission.
- 7) Submit the application form by clicking the "Submit Application" button.
