

### 4. Definitions

### 5. Procedure

The college takes keen efforts to maintain the campus green. Following procedure is adopted by the college.

**5.1 Appointed a Gardner:** A gardener is appointed by the college on annual basis for maintenance of Green Campus. He has to assigned duties related to regularly watering the plants, give the appropriate shapes, maintain the lawn, plant the new ornamental variety of herbs/shrubs, and apply fertilizers and pesticides whenever needed.

**5.2 Landscaping with trees and plants:** Landscaping of the college reflects aesthetic sense towards the green campus policy. The institute has a canopy of trees and plants to make the environment pollution free and safeguard the health of all the inmates. The lawns and the trees provide shade and beautiful ambience in the campus. Utmost care is taken to develop and maintain green landscaping by trained gardeners and supervisor.

#### 5.3 initiatives for greening the campus

The institutional initiatives for greening the campus are as follows:

**5.3.1 Restricted entry of automobile:** In the college campus, the entry of vehicle is restricted after the gate next to parking section. It helps to maintain the main educational area free from sound and air pollution.

**5.3.2 Use of Bicycle/ battery powered vehicles:** The college uses the Battery-powered vehicles for in-house transport. The college shall encourage the students from nearby places to prefer bicycle over other modes of transport for attending the college.




