## **Common Entrance Test (MJCET 2020)**

A Common Entrance Examination procedure will be adopted for admission to First Year Courses at Moolji Jaitha College in following subjects:

- Bachelors of Computer Application (BCA)
- Bachelors of Business Administration (BBA)

### **Admission Process**

The registration process for CET shall be online. The student will have to visit <http://mjcollege.kces.in> and click on link to register for MJCET 2020. While filling out the form ensure that following documents are available with student.

- Original Scanned Copy of SSC Marksheet
- Original Scanned Copy of HSC Marksheet (if available)
- Scanned Copy of Caste Certificate and Non Creamy Layer Certificate (if applicable)
- Scanned copy of Aadhar Card
- Scanned Passport size Photograph.
- Screenshot of Payment proof of MJCET fees.

After successfully filling the online form, the acknowledgement of the same will be mailed to student. In case any discrepancy is noted in the form, student will be contacted and told to fill a revised form. CET Examination FEES of Rs 300 should be paid online before filling the online registration form. The details of online payment are as follows:

Students shall keep a copy of payment proof with them and attach one copy to online registration form. It is Compulsory for a student to attempt CET for getting admission to above mentioned courses.

### **Eligibility Criteria**

- Eligibility criteria for appearing for CET: Candidates for XII or equivalent or XII Pass
- Course Specific Eligibility Criteria:

Sr. No.	Course	Specific Eligibility
1	BCA (Under Faculty of Science & Technology)	1) A candidate for being eligible for admission to any of the Degree courses shall have passed 12th Std. Examination (H.S.C. 10+2) from any stream with English as passing subject and has secured 45% marks at 12th Std.
2	BBA (Under Faculty of Commerce & Management)	2) Two years Diploma in Pharmacy after H.S.C., Board of Technical Education conducted by Government of Maharashtra or its equivalent. 3) Three Year Diploma Course (after H.S.C., i.e. 10th Standard) of Board of Technical Education conducted by Government of Maharashtra or its equivalent. 4) MCVC

\* In addition to above, the candidate must have appeared and qualified in MJCET Examination held by the School of Commerce & Management.

### Rules of Entrance Examination:

- The mode of entrance examination will be online form. The student can attempt the exam from their home through their smart phones or computers. The link to exams and username and password shall be mailed to them 5 days prior to the exams.
- The student must attempt the examination on the specified day and time mentioned to them in the email.
- The question paper will consist of only objective questions.
- Each question has four options, out of each only one is correct.
- Entrance examination consists of single paper of 45 minutes duration that contains 50 questions carrying maximum of 100 marks.

### Syllabus for Entrance Examination (up to 10+2 level):

- English Vocabulary and Grammar
- General Aptitude
- Basic IT
- Current Affairs

### Steps in MJCET Process:

- Read the instructions given in information brochure carefully.
- Pay CET examination fees at the account mentioned in the information brochure above. Preserve the payment slip containing UTR No. of the transaction.
- Visit <http://mjcollege.kces.in> and click on registration link for MJCET.
- Fill up the Online Application Form as per the given instructions.
- Attach the necessary documents along with the form.

- Submit screenshot of proof of payment of fees Rs 300 and submit the form. The candidate shall receive the acknowledgement on their registered email.
- Last Date of Online Filling Application form is **22<sup>nd</sup> August 2020**
- In case of any discrepancy/deficiency in the application form/attached documents; you are required to intimate the deficiencies to Admission Counseling Center before the last date of submission of application form the contact details of the Admission Counselors is available on <http://mjcollege.kces.in>
- The list of eligible candidates for appearing to MJCET will be available on the website.
- The list of eligible candidates for appearing to MJCET will not be published in any newspaper or will not be communicated to any candidate personally by post.
- If the candidate has any objection related with the merit list, he/she may contact the Admission Counseling Center and submit his/ her objection with proper documents.
