Allocation of seats

The percentage of allocation of seats for various types of candidates in the Home University (HU), Other than Home University (OHU), Institutional (Management) Quota, and Industry Sponsored Seats is as follows:

1. Allocation Seats for Granted Courses

- Candidates graduated from KBCNMU, Jalgaon : 90%
- Candidates graduated from other universities : 10%

2. Allocation Seats for Non Granted Courses

- Candidates graduated from KBCNMU, Jalgaon : 70%
- Candidates graduated from other universities : 10%
- Seats to be allotted through management quota : 20%

3. Allocation of seats will be as per the merit and eligibility of student for opted course.

4. In case of any dispute or discrepancy regarding grant of seat and eligibility, the decision taken by the Hon'ble Principal shall be final.

Reservations:

All the reservations given below shall be applicable to candidates belonging to Maharashtra state only subject to the fulfilment of the eligibility criteria specified by respective authorities from time to time.

(a) **Reservation for backward class category candidates:** The percentage of seats reserved for candidates of backward class categories belonging to Maharashtra state is as given below. The percentage of reservation is the percentages of the seats available for Maharashtra candidates. Backward class candidates shall claim the category to which they belong to at the time of submission of application form.

(b) Reservation for wards of defence service personnel: Five percent (5%) seats out of total sanctioned intake capacity of college as a whole separately, subject to a maximum of one (01) seat in each subject coming under CAP shall be reserved for wards of ex- service personnel who are from Maharashtra state.

(c) Reservation for persons with disability candidates: Five percent (5%) seats of total sanctioned intake capacity of a college as a whole separately, subject to a maximum of one (01) seat in each subject coming under CAP shall be reserved for candidates with disability. The allotment of seats reserved for the candidates with disability shall be done on the basis of merit. The candidates claiming reservation under this category shall submit the Physical Disability certificates.

Note: - Candidates with disability should note that on admission to degree course they will not be given any exemptions or additional facility in the academic activities other than those which may be provided by the college.

Government of India (GOI) has prescribed the following list of twenty-one types disabilities for Specially/Differently Abled Persons’:

(d) If the reservation quota remains vacant then 2% seats of total intake capacity of a college as a whole separately will be offered to SBC category.

(e) **Reservation for EWS (Economical Weaker Section) Candidate:** As per the provisions in Government Resolution No. राआधो-4019/ प्र. क्र.1/16- अ, dated 12th February 2019, 10% seats shall be reserved for EWS candidates. These seats shall be filled by the Competent Authority through CAP as per the policies of the Government declared from time to time.

(f) If sufficient candidates from Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University area are not available for admission for various post graduate courses, candidates from other universities will be considered. Similarly, if candidates from other universities are not available for admission, the candidates from Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University will be considered for admission. There will be separate merit list for other university students.

(g) Any change from Government side in terms of reservation before the commencement of allotment of seats will be taken under consideration.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE AND GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1) Use <https://mjcollege.kces.in/> web portal for admission to F.Y.M.A. courses.
- 2) Candidate must provide at least one **valid mobile number** and **e-mail ID** for creation of user ID.
- 3) Candidate should adhere to the rules and regulations of the college for the smooth conduct of admissions (A.Y. 2022-2023).
- 4) Candidate should scan all the required documents in proper format (i.e. .jpg/.jpeg) [Document size: Photo & Sign: 10kb-100kb, All other documents: 10kb-500kb] and keep ready to upload online with application form.
- 5) Applications with incorrect/wrong information will not be considered in the process of admission.
- 6) Registered candidates for different courses will be intimated only through the registered mobile no. and e-mail ID.

HOW TO APPLY ONLINE?

- 1) Download the prospectus from official college website <https://mjcollege.kces.in/> and read the instructions carefully before filling up the application form.
- 2) Click on "**Admissions 2022-23**" on home page to apply for the academic year **2022-2023**.
OR directly visit to <https://www.kcesmjc.in/>.
- 3) Then click on '**New Student Admission**', apply for respective course of FYMA and create candidate's user ID using valid mobile number and e-mail ID.
- 4) Again login through '**Already Registered Student**' link and fill all the required details carefully along with valid Aadhar Card details.

- 5) **Scan and attach all required original documents** specified in the application form with latest coloured passport size photograph and signature for procuring of identity card.
- 6) **Documents must be properly scanned and uploaded.**
- 7) **Preview** all the information entered once again and edit, if required, before submission.
- 8) Submit the application form by clicking the "**Submit Application**" button.
- 9) After submitting the application form candidates will not be able to change any information in it. If he/she wants to change any information before the dead line, then he/she has to contact system administrator/counsellors personally in the college office with documentary evidences.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE AFTER FORM SUBMISSION:

- 1) Login at your account using 'User ID' and 'Password' at <https://www.kcesmjc.in/> after form submission, fees payment option will be available at your account
- 2) Complete the fees payment process by choosing Pay online option. You may also pay the fees at cash counter of college.
- 3) After fees payment, download and print a copy of filled application form along with paid fees challan / receipt.
- 4) Submit an application form and receipt of fees paid along with the following necessary documents (original and photocopies) at 'Admission and Eligibility Section' in the college office for final verification and confirmation of admission **within 5 days after online submission.**
