M.Sc. - Admission Procedure and General Information

Sanctioned intake for various courses:

The sanctioned intake for first year M.Sc. courses shall be as per the affiliation and approval given by the university.

In addition to regular intake mentioned in the above table, **02 (two)** seats are available for industry sponsored candidates.

Note: Any change in intake capacity/seats by University will be applicable for this process.

Allocation of seats

The percentage of allocation of seats for various types of candidates in the Home University (HU), Other than Home University (OHU), Institutional (Management) Quota, and Industry Sponsored Seats is as follows:

- Candidates graduated from KBC NMU, Jalgaon : 70%
- Candidates graduated from other universities : 10%
- Seats to be allotted through management quota : 20%

Industry sponsored seats: one (01) seat for first ten (10) intake capacities, subject to maximum two per course.

Admission procedure for industry sponsored candidates:

- 1) For application under industry sponsored quota, it is mandatory to fill online application form.
- 2) After the counselling round, candidates with industry sponsorship may apply under the industry sponsored quota with a letter of sponsorship from the industry.
- 3) Admission under industry sponsored quota will be done purely on the basis of merit list prepared by the college.
- 4) Candidate once admitted through industry sponsored quota will not be allowed to shift to general quota under any circumstances.

Reservations:

All the reservations given below shall be applicable to candidates belonging to Maharashtra state only subject to the fulfilment of the eligibility criteria specified by respective authorities from time to time.

a) Reservation for backward class category candidates:

The percentage of seats reserved for candidates of backward class categories belonging to Maharashtra state is as given below. The percentage of reservation is the percentages of the seats available for Maharashtra candidates. Backward class candidates shall claim the category to which they belong to at the time of submission of application form.

b) Reservation for wards of defence service personnel:

Five percent (3%) seats out of total sanctioned intake capacity of colleges as a whole separately, subject to a maximum of one seat in each subject coming under admission procedure shall be reserved for wards of ex-service personnel who are from Maharashtra state.

c) Reservation for persons with disability candidates:

Five percent (3%) seats of total sanctioned intake capacity of college as a whole separately, subject to a maximum of one (01) seat in subject coming under admission procedure shall be reserved for candidates with disability.

The allotment of seats reserved for the candidates with disability shall be done on the basis of merit. The candidates claiming reservation under this category shall submit the Physical Disability certificates.

Note: - Candidates with disability should note that on admission to degree course they will not be given any exemptions or additional facility in the academic activities other than those which may be provided by the college.

d) If the reservation quota remains vacant then 2% seats of total intake capacity of college as a whole separately will be offered to SBC category.

e) Reservation for persons suffering from Cancer: A maximum one seat per course per institute can be allotted to candidates suffering from Cancer based on their merit. Such candidates shall submit the necessary certificate duly signed by a Civil Surgeon.

f) Reservation for EWS (Economical Weaker Section) Candidate: As per the provisions in Government Resolution No. राआधो -4019/ प्र.क्र. .31/16- अ, dated 12th February, 2019, **10% seats shall be reserved for EWS candidates.** These seats shall be filled by the Competent Authority through admission procedure as per the policies of the Government declared from time to time.

g) Reservation for SEBC: According to 'The Maharashtra state reservation for socially and educationally backward classes act, 2024, (Section 5), dated 29th February, 2024, 10% seats shall be reserved for SEBC candidates in educational institutions including private educational institutions, whether aided or un-aided by the State, other than minority educational institutions referred to in clause (1) of article 30 of the Constitution of India.

- h) If sufficient candidates from Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University area are not available for admission for various post graduate courses, candidates from other universities will be considered. Similarly, if candidates from other universities are not available for admission, the candidates from Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University will be considered for admission. There will be separate merit list for other university students.
- i) Any change from Government side in terms of reservation before the commencement of admission procedure Round -I will be taken under consideration.
- j) In case of any dispute or discrepancy regarding reservation and eligibility, the decision taken by the Hon'ble Principal shall be final.

3	Botany	B.Sc. (Botany), If seats remain vacant, those seats will be equally distributed among candidates with B.Sc. Agriculture, B.Sc. Life Sciences, B.Sc. Forestry, B.Sc. Horticulture., B.Sc. Applied Biology
4	Computer Science	B.Sc. (Computer Science), B.Sc. Data Science, B.E./B.Tech. Computer Science / Computer Engineering / Information Technology If seats remain vacant then B.Voc. (Software Development) will be considered for admission.
5	Geography	B.A./B.Sc. (Geography)
6	Mathematics	B.Sc. (Mathematics) or B.Sc. in any other subject with Mathematics at S.Y.B.Sc. level with minimum 50% Marks/CGPA in Mathematics. Preference will be given to B.Sc. (Mathematics)
7	Microbiology	B.Sc. (Microbiology), If seats remain vacant, those seats will be distributed among candidates with B.Sc. Applied Biology.
8	Organic Chemistry	B.Sc. (Chemistry)
9	Physics	B.Sc. (Physics)
10	Zoology	B.Sc. (Zoology), If seats remain vacant, those seats will be equally distributed among candidates with B.Sc. Life Sciences, B.Sc. Fishery Science., B.Sc. Applied Biology.

Preparation of merit list:

Assignment of merit number: - All the eligible candidates who have submitted online application form on or before the last date specified for the online submission. The merit list shall be prepared on the basis of score obtained at qualifying examination and the specific eligibility mentioned above.

Change of marks due to verification: - If the marks in the qualifying examination are modified due to verification/redressal and the same is duly certified by the concerned competent authority, the same shall be reported to the competent authority for admission through admission procedure or its designated representatives immediately. However, the effect of such change will be taken into consideration only for the subsequent round(s) of admission.

Method of calculating marks at qualifying examination for deciding eligibility: -

- (a) The group wise or subject wise separate general merit list for Home University and other than home university for eligible candidates will be generated on the basis of their performance at the graduation as per eligibility criteria.
- (b) The marks/CGPA obtained by the candidate in principal subject at second and third year of graduation will be considered while preparing merit list. The marks/CGPA will be converted to 10 Point CGPA Scale.
- (c) The tie cases of the candidates will be resolved as:
 - (i) On the basis of total marks/CGPA of second year at graduate level,
 - (ii) On the basis of first year marks/CGPA,
 - (iii) On the basis of marks obtained at H.S.C. and finally
 - (iv) On the basis of date of birth of the candidate.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR ADMISSION PROCEDURE:

- 1) Download the Prospectus from www.kcesmjcollege.in and read the instructions carefully before filling up the Application Form.
- 2) Use <https://mjcollege.kces.in/> web portal for admission to M.Sc. Classes.
- 3) Candidate must provide at least one **valid mobile number** and **e-mail ID** for creation of user ID as a direct contact made with college office.
- 4) Candidates should adhere to the rules and regulations of the college for the smooth conduct of admissions (2026-2027).

- 5) Applications with incorrect/wrong information will not be considered in the process of admission.
- 6) Selected/waitlisted candidates for different courses will be intimated only through the registered mobile no. and e-mail ID. The list of such candidates will be displayed on the college notice board and admission portal (Website).
- 7) All the aspiring candidates shall fill in the online application form for M.Sc. admission available on the college website.
- 8) The candidate should fill the online application form as per the notified schedule for respective admission
- 9) The candidates will be able to fill in online application form through any computer connected to internet.
- 10) After filling the information and submission of application form, he/she shall verify the data filled and correct it if required.
- 11) The candidate has to take the printout of application form and the receipt of payment generated in the online application form for your reference.
- 12) In case of any dispute or discrepancy regarding grant of seat and eligibility, the decision taken by the Hon'ble Principal shall be final.

HOW TO APPLY ONLINE?

- 1) Download the prospectus from official college website <https://mjcollege.kces.in/> and read the instructions carefully before filling up the application form.
- 2) First create your **ABC /APAAR ID** using <https://www.abc.gov.in/> OR <https://www.digilocker.gov.in/> . If you already have your ABC ID, please keep its copy with you for admission.
- 3) On home page of college website (<https://mjcollege.kces.in/>) click on "**Admissions 2026-27**" to apply for the academic year **2026-2027**. **OR** directly visit to <https://www.kcesmjce.in/>.
- 4) Then click on '**New Student Admission**', apply for respective course of F.Y.M.Sc. and create candidate's user ID using valid mobile number and e-mail ID.
- 5) Again login through '**Already Registered Student**' link and fill all the required details carefully along with valid Aadhar Card number.
- 6) **Scan and attach all required original documents** specified in the application form with latest coloured passport size photograph and signature for procuring of identity card. [Document size: Photo & Sign: 10kb-100kb, All other documents: 10kb-500kb].

- 7) **Documents must be properly scanned and uploaded.**
- 8) Save the application form by clicking the "Save" button.
- 9) Check all information entered once again and edit, if required, before submission.
- 10) **Preview** all the information entered once again and edit, if required, before submission.
- 11) Submit the application form by clicking the "**Submit Application**" button.
- 12) Students have to pay the registration fees of Rs.300/-.
- 13) After submitting the application form candidates will not be able to change any information in it. If he/she wants to change any information before the dead line, then he/she has to contact system administrator/counsellors personally in the college office with documentary evidences.
- 14) Important Note: While filling the marks of TYBSc, please fill only **Principal Subject's marks** as admission will be based on the marks obtained in only Principal Subject at graduation level.

If principal subject's marks are not available on mark sheet, please calculate it using following formula:

[Total **marks obtained** in Principal/Major Subjects at FYBSc + SYBSc + TYBSc]

[**Total marks** of Principal/Major Subjects at FYBSc +SYBSc + TYBSc]

ADMISSION PROCEDURE AFTER SEATS ALLOCATION:

- 1) As per the merit list, seat will allocated and Allotment letter/Slip will be issued in the respective department on the date of admission.
- 2) Then login at your admission account using 'User ID' and password and see the admission status as "Confirmed".
- 3) Initiate admission process and complete the fee payment process by choosing **Pay online** option. You may also pay the fees offline at cash counter of college.
- 4) Download and print a copy of filled **application form** along with **fee challan / receipt**.
- 5) Submit an application form and receipt of fee paid along with the following necessary documents at Admission Section of college for final confirmation of admission.
