




Guest lecture on Identification and representation of prerequisite of problem solving

Department of Computer Science



A webinar on careers in IT and Job opportunity :


Department of Computer Science




A guest lecture on Coding Tools: Department of Computer Science



- ❖ **Title of the Workshop:** One-Day Workshop on “Pearl Culture in Freshwater Bivalves for the Farmers of Melghat Area”
- ❖ **Date and Venue:**

❖ **Introduction and Objectives:** The Melghat region, predominantly agricultural, faces various economic challenges. To address the need for livelihood diversification and income augmentation for the farming community, this one-day workshop on "Pearl Culture in Freshwater Bivalves" was conceptualized. Freshwater pearl culture presents a viable and potentially lucrative allied agricultural activity that can utilize existing water resources.

The primary objectives of the workshop were:

- To introduce the concept and economic potential of freshwater pearl culture to the farmers of the Melghat area.
- To impart fundamental knowledge regarding freshwater bivalve biology and the pearl formation process.
- To provide an overview of the techniques involved in pearl cultivation, from bivalve selection to pearl harvesting.
- To discuss the necessary infrastructure, pond management practices, and post-operative care for bivalves.
- To create awareness about the potential for entrepreneurship and skill development in aquaculture among local farmers and students.

❖ **Workshop Proceedings and Key Sessions:** The workshop commenced with an inaugural session where; Dr. Manojkumar Z. Chopda inaugurated the Hands-On training programme. The representatives from the collaborating institutions welcomed the participants and highlighted the significance of such skill-development initiatives. Experts Dr. Manojkumar Z. Chopda from Moolji Jaitha College (Autonomous) Jalgaon and Dr. Mrs. Hemlata Nandurkar from Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University and resource persons with experience in aquaculture conducted the Hands-on Training and Technical sessions respectively.

Key topics covered during the workshop included:

- **Introduction to Pearl Culture:** Basics of pearl formation, types of pearls, and the scope of freshwater pearl farming in India.
- **Biology of Freshwater Mussels:** Understanding the anatomy and life cycle of local freshwater bivalve species suitable for pearl culture.

- **Pearl Culture Techniques:** Detailed explanation of site selection, pond preparation, sourcing and selection of healthy bivalves, pre-operative conditioning, surgical implantation techniques (grafting), and post-operative care.
- **Farm Management:** Water quality management, feeding, disease prevention, and protection from predators.
- **Harvesting and Processing:** Techniques for harvesting pearls, cleaning, grading, and basic value addition.
- **Economic Aspects and Marketing:** Discussion on the investment required, expected returns, potential challenges, and avenues for marketing cultured pearls.
- **Interactive Session:** A dedicated question-and-answer session allowed farmers and students to clarify their doubts and interact directly with the experts. Demonstrative aids and visual presentations were used to enhance understanding.
- ❖ **Participation:** The workshop witnessed enthusiastic participation from the target groups. A total of:
 - **29 farmers** from the Dharani area and surrounding villages in Melghat attended the workshop.
 - **16 students**, primarily from the collaborating colleges with an interest in life sciences and aquaculture, also participated.
- ❖ **Outcomes and Impact:** The workshop was successful in achieving its intended objectives.
 - **For Farmers:** The participating farmers gained valuable insights into a novel agricultural allied activity. Many expressed keen interest in exploring pearl culture as an alternative income source. The knowledge shared equipped them with the foundational understanding required to potentially initiate small-scale pearl farming operations. The workshop served as a catalyst for considering diversification beyond traditional farming.
 - **For Students:** The students were exposed to the practical aspects of aquaculture and entrepreneurship in the fisheries sector. The workshop provided them with a clearer understanding of the scientific principles behind pearl formation and the technicalities of its cultivation, potentially inspiring them to pursue further studies or projects in this domain.
 - **Networking:** The event facilitated interaction between farmers, students, and academic experts, opening avenues for future support and guidance.
- ❖ **Conclusion:** The one-day workshop on “Pearl Culture in Freshwater Bivalves for the Farmers of Melghat Area” served as a crucial platform for knowledge dissemination and skill awareness. 

Department of Botany


